Report to Argyll and Bute Council, Bute and Cowal Area Committee, June 2024

After recovering from the Covid-19 pandemic, there has been an upturn in activity in financial year 2023/24.

As in previous years, the Trust provided support to Village Halls in Glendaruel and Colintrave which facilitate a range of activities for communities, thanks to their respective hard-working Committees. Much appreciated were the subsidised Christmas meal at Colintrave and at Glendaruel.

In December, in response to continuing cost of living pressures, the Trust was able to fund a further payment of £150 to every permanent household in the area. This was administered by Colintrave & Glendaruel Development Trust.

The range of grants provided has resulted in a substantial balance over the year. However, with an expected receipt of around £44,000 from ScottishPower Renewables, the Trust can continue to offer generous support to the community of Colintrave and Glendaruel in the year ahead.
