

MINIBUS HIRES

From the 08th June 2015, the paper counterpart to the photocard driving licence will no longer be valid and will no longer be issued by DVLA. The counterpart was introduced to display driving licence details that could not be included on the photocard. These details include some vehicle categories drivers are entitled to drive and any endorsement/penalty points.

After 08th June 2015, a paper counterpart will no longer have any legal status. Argyll and Bute Council will therefore have to change how it checks the validity of licences and penalty point endorsements prior to issuing keys for minibus hires.

Customers will be required to provide the following information each time they make a hire:

- x Photocard driving licence
- x Print a summary or a check code generated from the UK Government's
